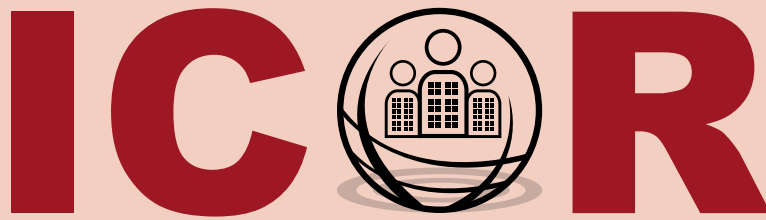

ISO 22301 Lead Auditor Training Course and ANSI Accredited Exam

ISO 22301 Lead Auditor is a 5-day instructor-led course that teaches the principles and practices of independent auditing of a Business Continuity Management System (BCMS) and guides the student through the audit process using a balance of formal instruction and practical case study activities.



The course provides students with the skills and knowledge to conduct and lead effective business continuity management system audits in accordance with the requirements of ISO 22301: 2012, ISO 19011: 2012, and ISO 17022: 2012 and an in-depth study of each of these standards as well as ISO 22313: 2012.

The course is constructed around a case study and each activity is applied to the case study as we move through the course. Course materials include, templates for “standards” compliance, an auditor questionnaire and toolkit, and templates for planning an audit and writing the report.

The ISO 22301 Lead Auditor course is accredited by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI). Upon completion of the course and passing the exam with a rate of 80% or higher, attendees will earn an ANSI Accredited certificate as an ISO 22301 Lead Auditor. 3.5 CEUs / 35 credit hours. In addition, the ISO 22301 Lead Auditor exam is accredited by PECB and can be used as evidence to pursue certification as an auditor once you have completed the required number of audit hours. 2.1 CEUs
