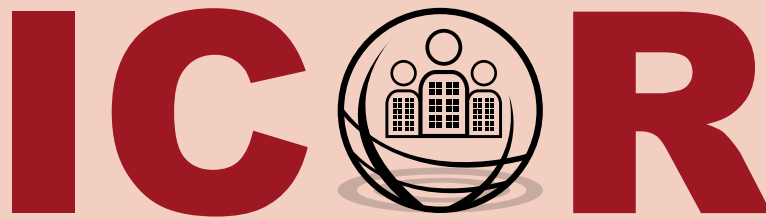

ISO 22301 Assessor

ISO 22301 Assessor is offered as a 2-day instructor led course. Using a case study approach and the ISO 22301 Maturity Model Assessment tool, participants learn how to conduct a self-assessment of an organisation's Business Continuity Management System (BCMS).

The focus of the course is on the requirements of ISO 22301 and how these requirements are implemented in a BCMS. Using the ISO 22301 Maturity Model as a tool for measuring alignment to ISO 22301, attendees receive a FREE electronic copy of the self-assessment tool as part of the course fee.
